The Mesabi Trail is paved and is approximately 135 miles stretches from the Mississippi to the Boundary Waters. Both trails are excellent for biking and hiking April-October and

Fishing: Itasca County has over 1,400 lakes, great fishing guides and boat rentals. Fall is a great time to spend fishing on the lake. No matter where you stay in the greater Grand Rapids area, you are always close to a lake.

Hunting: Bring along your favorite shotgun and bird dog. Working aspen forests and hunters' walking trails offer ruffed grouse hunters an exhilarating day in the field. White tail deer hunters can find a prime location within a short drive of Grand Rapids, although some research work is required in advance to find the right location on public lands. The mixed hardwood forests and numerous lakes provide excellent habitat for white tail deer.
