Mesabi Trail - Grand Rapids to Ely

Stretching from the Mississippi to the Boundary Waters (Grand Rapids to Ely), and with almost 135 miles of paved trail, the Mesabi Trail is like no other trail you have ever ridden!

Pedal past lakes, creeks and ponds, and by vast red pits left by old iron ore mines now filled with emerald green water. Pass through 28 communities, stop in at a local attraction to experience the history of the area, learn about our mining and logging legacies, enjoy the local cuisine...try a sarma, a pasty or some potica.

Built from old railway beds, old mining and logging roads, abandoned highway, and sometimes just blazing a trail through the woods to get to the next community, the Mesabi Trail is accessible from numerous entry points. Some of the highlights include pedaling across the tallest bridge in Minnesota just outside Virginia, and a three-quarter long floating bridge near Embarrass.

When completed, this well-mapped and well-maintained trail will traverse over 155 miles, making it one of the longest paved trails in the United States. Note, that we're still building on the east end of the trail, check our website for updates when planning your trip: www.mesabitrail.com



Tioga Recreation Area - Cohasset

Tioga Recreation Area is northern Minnesota's next premier outdoor adventure destination. Five hundred wooded acres located on two of the region's most unique lakes features 30 miles of world-class, single-track mountain biking, snowshoe trails, beaches,



and access to hundreds of miles of waterways. Every season is adventure season at Tioga.

In its heyday in the late 1950's, Tioga's No. 2 Mine shipped more than 3 million tons of iron ore. Tioga's mining days are long over, but the steep slopes and rocky outcroppings laid the groundwork for world-class mountain biking. More than 30 miles of professionally built single-track trails twist through the rock studded landscape, from family-friendly loops like Gurley Flynn to heart-pumping double blacks

like Bloodstone. There are jump lines, skills tracks, tech trails, downhill flow trails, and mil^{Kelly L}



the North. Glide across the turquoise blue waters of Tioga Mine Pit or pack your seal bag and put in on Pokegema Lake for the day. 6,600 acres of lake not enough for you? Tioga has you covered. Paddle from Pokegema Lake into to the Mississippi River and embark on the adventure of a lifetime.

year-round. Redhead has something for everyone – with nearly 25 miles of hand crafted, purpose built mountain bike trails already on the ground and more on the way. Difficulty ranges from beginner (easy) to expert level with a wide array of terrain features and options for riders to test out their skills. Redhead


